**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 2014-12 CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF  
STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR THE SOUTHPORT POLICE DEPARTMENT**

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**WHEREAS**, The City of Southport Police Department is subject to the Southport Board of Public Works and Safety (the “Board”) under Indiana Code § 36-8-3-2, which provides in pertinent part that the Board “may (1) adopt rules for the government and discipline of the police . . . department[]; and (2) adopt general and special orders to the police . . . department[] through the chief[] of the department[];” and

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council of the City of Southport adopted its Resolution 2014-12 on November 17, 2014, entitled “A Resolution Adopting the Southport Police Department’s Totally Revised Standard Operating Procedures;” and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 2014-12 approved certain Standard Operating Procedures of the Southport Police Department and provided “[t]hat any future policy revisions or additions be reviewed by the City Attorney and approved by the Board, then presented to the City Council before becoming effective;” and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City Council that the Board exercise the authority created and allowed to the Board by IND. CODE § 36-8-3-2 in the Board’s supervision of the Southport Police Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTPORT, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That all Standard Operating Procedures of the Southport Police Department previously approved by Resolution 2014-12 on November 17, 2014, as well as all Standard Operating Procedures of the Southport Police Department adopted since November 17, 2014, under the procedures established by Resolution 2014-12, and which are still in effect as of the date of this Resolution, remain in effect.

2. That any and all additions, deletions, or amendments to the Standard Operating Procedures of the Southport Police Department shall hereafter be made by the Board pursuant to such procedures as the Board may utilize, and without further review or request for approval by the Common Council. Any pending Standard Operating Procedures that, as of the date hereof, have been approved by the Board subject to approval of the Common Council under the procedures established by Resolution 2014-12 are included within the scope of this Resolution and this Paragraph 2 and are NOT required to be reviewed and approved by the Common Council but instead are effective as provided by the Board without further review, consideration, or action by the Common Council.
